Dear Mayor Watts:

As indicated in my December 3, 2009 letter, I am providing an update to your request for one ZIP Code in the City of Central, LA. After conducting an in-depth analysis (attached), I regret to inform you that the request for one ZIP Code in Central, LA is denied.

After quantifying the impacts and estimating the cost associated with your request, it is not feasible for us to make this change. An alternative to this request is to allow the use of more than one "city" name in the last line of the address, while retaining the ZIP Code of the delivery Post Office. **This would help with any community identity problem.**

Use of the Central city name already exists as Central, LA. The city name can be placed in the third line of the address, but with the corresponding Post Office ZIP Code (Pride - 70770, Zachary - 70791, Baker - 70714, and Greenwell Springs - 70739).
